Because using single sign on is also associated with the product's web user interface, the Infor CloudSuite Industrial integration guide for Infor Ming.le may include additional information about single sign on or Infor Federation Services.

## Requirements

- Installed Active Directory Federation Services (AD FS)
- Installed Infor Federation Services (IFS)
- More requirements and information are found in the Infor Ming.le Foundation Installation Guide for Standalone IFS and the Infor Federation Services Administration Guide.

## Installation and Configuration

For Infor CloudSuite Industrial version 9.00.30, you must first install SyteLine 9.00 and then install and apply the Infor CloudSuite Industrial service pack to get to the 9.00.30 level.

These are the documents you will need:

- Infor SyteLine Installation Guide version 9.00. This guide contains information about how to configure IFS and AD FS for single sign on.
- Infor CloudSuite Industrial Installation Guide version 9.00.30

## Verify

Once you have everything set up, close all applications, log out of your system(s) and then log back in. You should not be prompted for additional username and password information as you enter other applications that have been setup to use AD FS and IFS.
