Installing a Language Pack

The instructions in this document apply for all languages. Depending on the language of your language pack, the screen shots might be slightly different. The example screen shots contained in this document were taken from the German language pack. Some of the screen shots contain the name of the application or forms database in the title of the screen, so your screen titles may be different depending on the names of your databases.

Installing a language pack requires two steps depending on which language pack you are installing:

- Install the language pack language.
- Run the Infor Factory Track Configuration wizard.

Requirements

- Infor Factory Track must be installed.
- A minimum of SQL Client Connectivity software must be installed on the machine where the wizard is running.

Launch the Language Pack Language Install

1 Find setup.exe on the utility server. Run as administrator. This screen is displayed.



- 2 Click the Install Country Pack Language button.
- 3 The Welcome screen is displayed. No action is required on this screen. Click Next.
- 4 The Ready To Install the Program screen is displayed. Click Install.
- 5 After the installation is complete, click **Finish**.
- 6 If the After Installation screen is displayed, click Next and then Finish.

Run the Infor FactoryTrack Configuration Wizard

The Infor FactoryTrack Configuration Wizard should be run on the utility server only.

Find and run the Infor Factory Track Configuration Wizard. On older operating systems, select Start
 All Programs > Infor > Setup > Infor Factory Track Configuration Wizard.

On newer operating systems, the wizard is found under Apps. The Welcome screen is displayed. For Installing Translations:

2 Select Translation component. Click Next. The Select Translations To Load screen is displayed.

- 7 When the installation completes, the Finish Factory Track Configuration Wizard Screen appears. Click **Finish**.
- 8 Repeat steps 1 through 6 for each language pack you install.

Post Installation Steps

After installing all required pieces above, you must perform the following steps.

- 1 Download and apply any available On-Demand Patches if necessary.
- 2 On the utility server, stop and restart the Infor Framework IDO Runtime Service.
- 3 Log in to Factory Track, and select the desired language (View > User Preferences > Runtime Behaviors).
- 4 Go to Sites form and set the language to the required value.
- 5 Go to SiteParameters form and click Generate Strings View, Generate Component View and Generate Menus View buttons.
- 6 Unload all global form objects (Form > Definition > Unload All Global Form Objects).
- 7 If you need data collection web pages to display properly in the Chinese language, do the following:
 - In the Regional and Language settings (found in Control Panel and named slightly differently depending on your operating system) on the utility server, install East Asian Languages.
 - Still in the Regional and Language settings, on the **Advanced** tab, select Chinese (PRC) for "Language for non-Unicode programs".
 - Install the Chinese Language Pack translations (strings) to the Forms database.
 - On the client machine, Under **Regional and Language Options**, Install East Asian Languages.
 - In Internet Explorer, under Tools > Options > Languages (path names might be slightly different depending on your version of Internet Explorer), add language preference Chinese (China) [zh-cn] in the first position.
 - In Internet Explorer, select View > Encoding > Chinese Simplified (GB2312).
