Intended audience

All users, managers, supervisors, and MIS personnel upgrading to Infinium Project Accounting (PA) Release 14.0 should read these release notes.

Purpose of these release notes

These release notes summarize the enhancements, discrepancy corrections, and menu changes in Infinium PA Release 14.0. The release notes provide brief explanations of the changes and include technical information where appropriate.

IMPORTANT: Infinium AM Release 3.0 provides a new function that generates a Changed Objects report that lists the objects that changed since Infinium PA Release 13.1. You can now generate the list of changed objects for Infinium PA Release 14.0.

To generate this report, access Infinium AM, select *AM Utilities*, and then select *Print Changed Objects* in the *Install Functions* menu. You can run the report before or after you install this release. For more information, refer to the “Generating the Changed Objects report” topic in the *Infinium PA Installing Release 14.0* guide.

To supplement the information in the release notes, we updated sections of the Infinium PA guides with the detailed information about the changes in this release.

Chapter 2 Enhancements

This chapter describes the enhancements in Infinium PA Release 14.0. In addition to the enhancements described in this chapter, this release also provides full NLE and double-byte support of Infinium PA.

Close projects enhanced to use activity level account for general ledger transactions

You can now indicate at the project level close that the close account for the general ledger transactions should come from the activity being closed instead of from the project. You still have the option of specifying a close account at the project level close to use on all general ledger transactions created during the close of that project.

To support this enhancement, we added the required *Activity close account* field to the Close Projects screen. If you specify yes, the system uses the close account from the activity associated with the transaction being processed when the system generates the general ledger transaction. If the activity does not have a close account, the system uses the close account on this screen.

Note: The close account from the project is the default value in the *Close account* field, but you can change that value.

Project Close Summary report

When you run the *Close projects* function, the system now generates a third report, the Project Close Summary report. The report provides a consolidated view of all items closed, projects, activities, cost codes, and transactions, in Infinium PA and their corresponding descriptions.

Each line item on the report indicates what was selected for the close, which includes the project, activity, cost code, or transaction. The transaction information includes the transaction source and the transaction number.

The report also indicates if the close process generated general ledger entries, fixed asset entries, or simply closed in Infinium PA and did not generate additional entries. If the close generated general ledger or fixed assets entries, the report also lists the general ledger and fixed assets companies where applicable.

Chapter 3 Discrepancy Corrections

For the discrepancy correction in Infinium PA Release 14.0, the table lists the following information:

- Menu function - This is the name or names of the affected function or functions.
- Customer reference number, if one exists
- New or changed objects - This is the name of the new or changed object or objects, such as a software program or display file.
- Description - This is a brief summary of the correction to the problem.

The chapter consists of the discrepancy correction in the *Close projects* menu option in *Close and Transfer*.
