- **CORGSTAT** - Corporation Registered Address - State Code
- **CORGPCD** - Corporation Registered Address - Post Code  
These are sourced from the new Role Reason "Corporation Registered Address" details for a Nominee on Role Reason Maintenance, which is accessed using the Nominee grid "Role Reason" button on Property Names Maintenance.

## PROPERTY NAMES MAINTENANCE

The following changes have been made:

- The Nominee grid title has been changed to include the role type of the Name to which the Nominee relates. This is included in brackets at the end of the title. For example, "Nominees for Infor Global Solutions (Property Owner)".
- If the Reason is changed for a Nominee with existing Corporation Registered Address details present, a message will be displayed saying that these details may need to be reviewed.
- Previously, an error occurred in the rare situation where a Name was added and given a Reason and then the "Role Reason" grid button used without first saving the changes. A message will now be displayed in the situation saying that changes first need to be saved.

### EPATHWAY SINGLE LINE PROPERTY SEARCH

The ePathway General Enquiry Search now allows address searching using a single line instead of having to enter each address component separately. This functions in a similar manner to the single line address entry in User Registration, but instead of searching across name related addresses, it searches across the property address database.

Similarly, the Address search option when linking Properties to lodgements such as new Animals, Applications, Licenses and Customer Requests is subject to the same changes.

For example, Figure 1 shows how an address search is initially displayed for General Enquiry Rates if the new feature is enabled (see next section to see how to enable). There is now a new Address Component Search checkbox, and a single Address field is available for entry (see next section to tailor the labels).

The search engine will do its best to match as well as it can with respect to ranges of address numbers (including for units, flats, levels, and suites). In Figure 5 we have asked to match from numbers 1 to 5, and it has done its best to include addresses in that range, Figures 4 and 5.

The engine also tries to prioritise in the instance where we don't seem to have a perfect match. In Figure 6 we have asked for unit 1 on street number 2. Aardvark Alley has no units at number 2, so instead it has included street numbers that do have a unit 1 and street number 2.
