The User ID in the URL constructed by external GIS software for use with the UXWS GIS product integration in Pathway UX is now case insensitive so there is no longer a requirement for the external software to provide the User ID in uppercase in the URL.

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UXWS GIS PRODUCT ADDITIONAL FUNCTIONS

The parameters for this GIS product are found under the System Administration >> Integration >> GIS Parameters >> GIS Product Parameters menu option. Changes have been made to separate the details for the construction of the GIS URL into separate fields to improve useability and allow better validation of individual parts of the URL.

NOTE: The upgrade process will automatically split any existing UXWS parameters into the associated separate fields.

The Base URL is now separated from the new Query String field that allows the required static query string parameters to be defined.

There is a new optional field called Context that allows dynamic context parameters to be added to the query string in the constructed GIS URL. The dynamic values are populated via new substitution tokens. These can be used by the GIS software to customise the functions that are available or are performed to make these relevant to the context they were invoked in Pathway. The new label and substitution tokens for context are:

- formName={{context::FormName}}
- moduleCode={{context::ModuleCode}}
- modelName={{context::PrimaryModelName}}
- key={{context::PrimaryModelKey}}.

Any or all of these can be used to supply the context to the GIS software in the GIS URL and can be mapped to any query string parameter name supported by the GIS software.

The FormName is the Pathway form name that invoked the GIS display function, for example LPAG0010. The ModuleCode is the Pathway module, for example LPA. The PrimaryModelName is the name of the primary business object, for example lpaprop. The PrimaryModelKey is the primary key value to identify the individual business object, for example 1165708.

A Preview GIS URL button has been added. When activated, this will construct a URL from the parameter settings without substituting any values to allow the validity of the constructed URL to be checked as it is being defined:

In addition to these changes, the GISDISPLAY Workflow User Action now supports overriding parts of the constructed URL via Action Parameters for usage as a specific Workflow Task in modules that support Workflow.

These do not have to be overridden but when they are, it allows the GIS to be supplied with different parameters for each individual Workflow Task so the GIS can take different actions for each if supported by the GIS software.

If not provided, the value from the UXWS product parameters is used but when specified for the task the portion of the URL is replaced by the values defined in these action parameters.

The Response Hint, Context and Query String parameters are available to be overridden for each task.

These details and more are available in the updated version of the UXWS SDK called Pathway UXWS GIS Interface SDK - 1.03.pdf which is available on request.

This change allows greater control over the cookie properties and is done by using the standard ASP.Net HTTP cookie properties that are set within the system.web section of the Pathway UX web.config file. This is in preparation for future UX changes.

Previously, when using the Bulk function, the default Merge Type was not displayed when the form was loaded. The Merge Type details should be populated with the default Merge Type defined on the Request Type. If there is no default Merge Type on the Request Type, then the Merge Type details are not automatically populated.

A change has been made to the Statement Print and Document Printing functions, so that Debtor Document Delivery details are now available for inclusion in export files and Word documents.

The new Export Format Fields can be added to an Export Format using Export Format Datastring Maintenance (Debtors >> Housekeeping >> Export Format Data String Maintenance) by selecting the two new Fields available for the Statement Print and Document Printing:

- Debtor - Preferred Delivery Method
- Debtor - E-mail Address.

The new Merge Fields can be added to either a Statement and Letter Merge Type or a Document Merge Type:

- Dr_Pref_Deliv_Meth
- Dr_Email_Address.

The Preferred Delivery Method indicates the preferred method of delivering the document, and can be:

- P - Post
- E - E-mail
- F – Fax.

The E-mail Address is obtained from the Communication Details of the first current Identity (Name) on the given Debtor record.

As part of this change the Export Format Data String Maintenance form has been updated to use the latest Pathway UX user interface standards.

When a Pathway module generates Word Processing documents stored in external EDMS software it is now possible in Pathway UX to attempt to force a check in of a document that has been left checked out. This might occur, for example, if the external EDMS software encounters an error when checking in a modified document when requested to do so. When left in a checked-out state the normal operation of the integration will prevent any further editing, printing etc. Forcing the check in, if successful, can allow a user to recover from this situation without having to have an administrator in the external EDMS software do that task.

When applicable, the Document Request Maintenance form now has a Force Check In option on the Document data-grid:



If the document is not checked out when the Force Check In is attempted the user can expect to see a message like this displayed:



If the document is checked out the user will be prompted to confirm the action, it will be something like:







We are gradually enforcing a change to block custom scripts being injected via Page Layout.

If you are currently adding scripts (e.g. `<script>...</script>`) via Page Layout, you will need to take action to migrate them to *Page Inserts* in ePathway. Failure to do this will mean any custom javascript added via *Page Layout* will not execute as it did previously.

At this point, it is being enforced for ePathway Payments only but eventually it will be rolled out to all modules, so it is recommended you go through all modules to ensure there are no script tags being used.

To check whether you are using scripts in ePathway Payments you will need to:

1. Log into ePathway as an Administrator.
2. Go to Layout >> Page Layout >> ePathway Payments.
3. Go through each page and check that there are no `<script>` tags in any of the Description, Instructions or labels on any of the pages.



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

Furthermore, an override setting has been added to the Customer Service appConfig.js to allow the Actioning Officer field to also remember its previous selection. This essentially overrides the existing approach of defaulting to the "Logged On User" or "(All)", which is set in Smart Mobile Preferences:

Previously, the Water Billing Generation would complete abnormally when attempting to process a Master Meter with Slave Meters with Shared Percentages nominated, where the consumption of the Master Meter was less than the sum of the consumptions of the Slave Meters, and a Fixed or Unit Charge was to be applied to one or more of the Shared Meter Assessments.

As part of this correction, the following Exception Report message has been enhanced to include the consumption value of the Master Meter and the sum of the consumption values of the Slave Meters.

For example:

Master meter : M00144321 consumption (199) less than slaves (200).

A number of corrections have been made to Assessment Meter Maintenance and associated forms. Previously, the following problems occurred:

- When the Related Meters option was used to add a Related Meter (Master Meter or Deductive Meter) to an Assessment Meter, the Connection Type (which can be either Normal, Master, Deductive or Slave) of the Assessment Meter was not updated to the correct value until the next time Assessment Meter Maintenance was accessed again for that Assessment Meter.

- When adding an Assessment Meter, the Status was maintainable when it should not have been.
- When adding an Assessment Meter, a Loading indicator would appear multiple times after leaving the Meter ID and Serial Number even after a valid Meter Id or Serial Number had been entered. This sometimes incorrectly blanked out or overwrote the Install Date after it had been entered.
- If an Assessment Search was performed that returned multiple Assessments in the search results, then it was incorrectly possible to be able to click on a different Assessment in the search results when in the following forms, potentially resulting in invalid combinations of Assessments and Meters being displayed:
 - Assessment Meter Maintenance.
 - Related Meter Selection.
 - Related Meter Maintenance.

RELATED METER MAINTENANCE

- In the situation where a Master Meter was related to two (or more) different Slave Meters, attempting to remove the Master Meter from one of the Slaves (by pressing the Delete button) could result in an error message (e.g. The Meter cannot be deleted as it has Related Meters. All Related Meters must be deleted before this Meter can be deleted.) and/or the Master Meter could have been removed from a Slave Meter different to the one that was being maintained.
- When adding a Related Meter, a Loading indicator would appear multiple times after leaving the Meter ID and Serial Number even after a valid Meter Id or Serial Number had been entered. And this sometimes incorrectly blanked out or overwrote the Install Date after it had been entered.

MASTER SHARE MAINTENANCE
