SQL NESTED QUERIES

Some dynamically created queries within Pathway can be too complex and the SQL Server will fail to process and an error is displayed within the Application server log:

Some part of your SQL statement is nested too deeply. Rewrite the query or break it up into smaller queries.

A known cause is when the query restricts the items by a large number of known IDs, for example, specific user IDs. This has been overcome by limiting when SQL is used for this filtering.

MAIL AND FAX SERVER DETAILS

This release adds the capability to send outgoing email from Pathway via Microsoft 365 Exchange Online using the Graph API instead of SMTP.

In 2024, Microsoft announced that it would be removing the option to use Basic Authentication (username and password) when sending email using SMTP via Exchange Online. See <https://techcommunity.microsoft.com/blog/exchange/exchange-online-to-retire-basic-auth-for-client-submission-smtp-auth/4114750>.

Removal of Basic Authentication for SMTP client submission will directly affect any Pathway customers that currently route email out directly via Exchange Online. Note that customers using an on-prem SMTP server might not be affected.

The addition of support for the Graph API offers customers a way to continue to send email via Exchange Online without the need to configure alternative services or provision new servers.

Limitations

In general, email messages sent via Graph to Exchange Online behave no differently than if they were sent using SMTP but there are some exceptions:

- **Cannot relay from arbitrary email addresses**
While an SMTP relay mail server may accept and send emails with any arbitrary From' (sender) address, when using Graph with Exchange Online, the 'From' address must correspond to an existing user mailbox or shared mailbox.
- **Cannot directly specify alternate message body for HTML messages**
Pathway email templates support the configuration of plain text and HTML bodies. In the case where an email template has both a plain text and html body, both of these are included in the email message. The purpose behind this is to allow the recipients email software to decide which rendition to display to the user based on the capabilities of the display device and possibly the recipient's own preference. When an email is submitted to Exchange Online via Graph, only one version of the message body can be supplied. When this arises, the HTML body is used in preference to the plain text body. Note that the email that is finally sent to the recipient will still have an HTML and plain text version of the body, but the plain text version will have been automatically generated by Exchange Online.
- **Cannot directly specify Display Name for from addresses**
Whereas an email submitted by SMTP can have an arbitrary display name, this is not the case when using Graph and Exchange Online. Instead, the display name that will be used for an outgoing message will be whatever is configured as the display name for the mailbox. This affects Pathway anywhere that a user or administrator might type in a display name corresponding to a sending from address such as on the Mail Server Details panel on the Mail and Fax Server Maintenance page, or on an Email Template Maintenance page.

Implementation - Connectivity (refer to customer IT resources for assistance)

While sending email via Graph to Exchange Online, there will need to be HTTP connectivity from the Pathway Application and Batch Queue servers to the following endpoints:

- Microsoft Graph API: <https://graph.microsoft.com/v1.0>
- Microsoft Token Service: <https://login.microsoftonline.com/<tenant-id>/oauth2/token>.

Implementation - Exchange Online (refer to customer IT resources for assistance)

Every user that sends email from themselves in Pathway will need an Exchange Online mailbox with an address that corresponds to the address configured on that users Pathway account.

A user-specific mailbox or a shared mailbox must exist with an address that corresponds to the address configured as the Email From Address in the Mail Server Details section of Mail and Fax Server Maintenance.

A user-specific mailbox or a shared mailbox must exist with an address that corresponds to any manually defined From address configured on an Email Template, or anywhere else in Pathway.

Implementation - Entra (Azure AD) (refer to customer IT resources for assistance)

An Application Registration must be created in Microsoft 365 Entra (formerly Azure AD). This will need to be done by someone with the necessary permissions in your site's Microsoft 365 tenancy. The necessary parameters are as follows:

1. Display Name can be anything that suits the customer's naming policy. A suggestion might be PathwayEmail.
2. Grant the following Microsoft Graph Application permissions to the application
 1. Mail.Send
 2. Mail.ReadWrite.
3. Grant admin consent for the above permissions.

4. Create a Client Secret for the application:
 1. Set expiry according to local security policy requirement.
NOTE: A new secret will be required when this one expires - this needs to be actively managed.
 2. Make note of the Value; this is only available to be viewed/copied immediately after the secret is created.
5. In addition to the client secret value, the Application (client) ID will be required for configuration as well as the tenant ID.

Configure Pathway Mail in System Administration > System Parameters > Mail and Fax Server Maintenance > Mail Server Details:

1. Service Type: Microsoft 365
2. Microsoft 365 Authority:
3. Enter the URL for the Microsoft Token service, inserting the Microsoft 365 Tenant ID to replace <tenant_ID> https://login.microsoftonline.com/<tenant_ID>/oauth2/v2.0/token.
4. Microsoft 365 Application Client ID:
 - a. Enter the Application (Client) ID from the application registration.
 - b. Microsoft 365 Client Secret: Enter the value for the client secret.
 - c. Click on Save.
 - d. Send a test email to confirm that everything is working.
 - e. Cannot directly specify Display Name for 'from' addresses. Pathway email templates have a From field with a drop list of: Administrator, User or Other. Review email templates where Other has been used, as the display name will be ignored by Microsoft Exchange Online. If you need to set a specific display name it must be set in Microsoft Exchange Online on the mailbox.

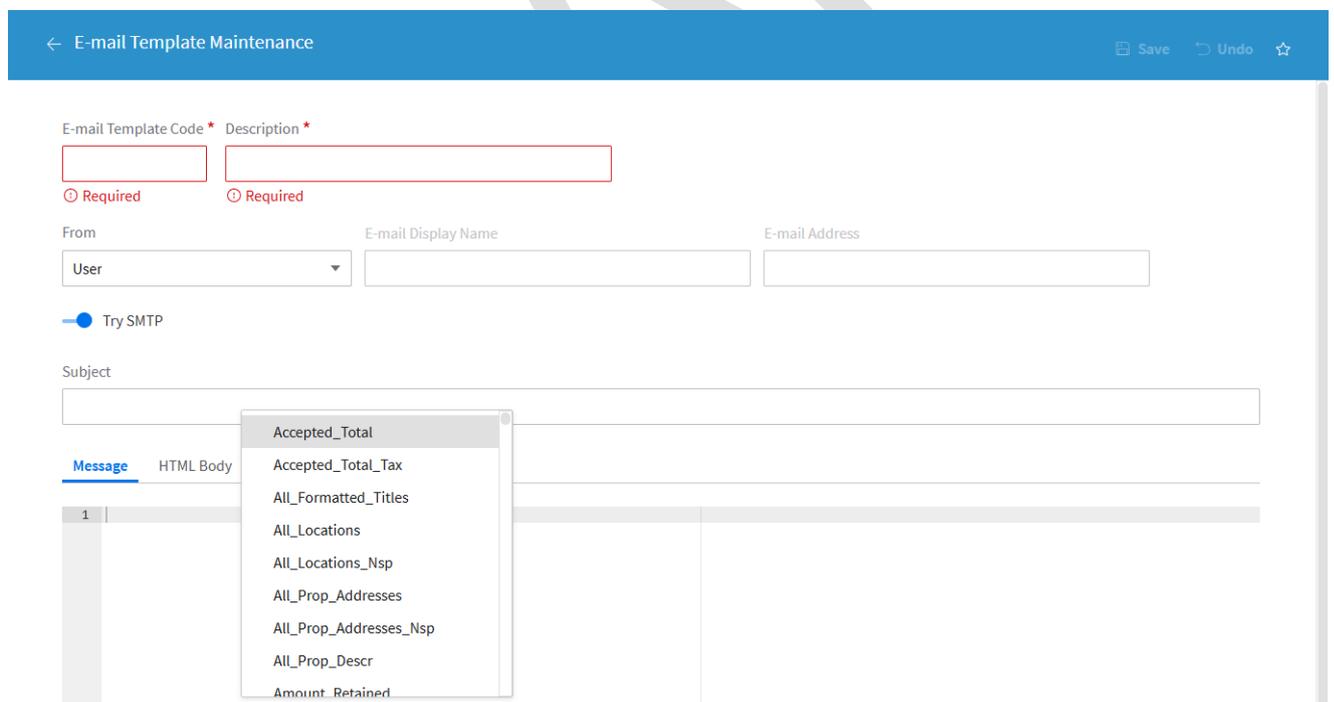

EXTERNAL WEB SERVICES - ENQUIRY SEARCHES FOR APPLICATIONS AND LICENSING

The External Web Services SDK has updated services to add extra Application/Licence filtering to replicate ePathway Enquiry List filtering, independent of ePathway parameters/installation.

The additional filtering added includes:

- Decision date range,
- Application/Licence types
- Application/Licence statuses
- Workflow task types
- Stakeholder roles (for Name searches).

The Application/Licence methods modified with these additional filters are:

- CIFV5550. FindApplications
- CIFV5550. FindApplicationsByName
- CIFV5550. FindApplicationsByLocation
- CIFV5550. FindLicences
- CIFV5550. FindLicencesByName
- CIFV5550. FindLicencesByLocation.

The CIFV5010. ClassType service method was also modified to include available Decision Types and Workflow Task Types for each Class so they can be identified by id for use the above filtering.

Three new elements have been added to the RequestData for the Receipting External Web Services SubmitPayment method:

1. <donotprefixbankref> - Optional. Do not prefix Bank Reference. It is a Boolean indicator, formatted as true or false, to indicate whether or not needs to apply a default prefix, which is XS, to the provided value of <bankreference>, when creating a Receipt via Pathway External Web Services. If value not provided, then the default value for this element is false, i. e. default prefix "XS" will be applied to table CRCRCPT's BANKREF field.
2. <donotsuffixbankref> - Optional. Do not suffix Bank Reference. It is a Boolean indicator, formatted as true or false, to indicate whether or not needs to append a suffix value, which is configured within Pathway for the provided value of <paymenttypecode>, when creating a Receipt. If value not provided, default value is false, i. e. a suffix value, if defined by Payment Type Code, will be applied.
3. <offlinereference> - Optional. Offline Reference Number. If value provided, it will be stored in table CRCRCPT's REFERENCE field.

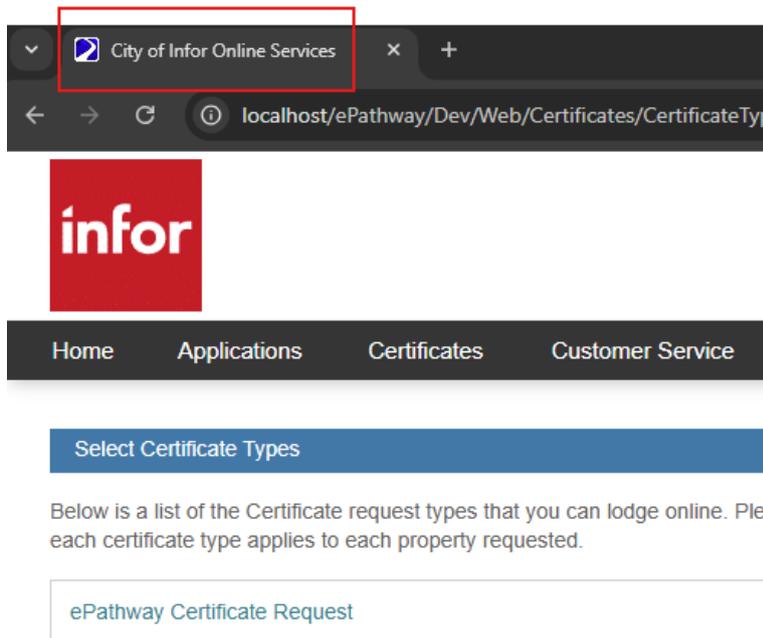

Now that online Response Enquiry is possible, a change has been made to separate the contact details into a new field called Personal Details on the response. This allows the actual response text (Summary Details) to be publicly exposed and keep any Personal Details hidden.

As a result of this change an additional Personal Details field is now able to be included, if desired, on the Response Enquiry detail screen.

NOTE: A Web Server Export will need to be performed before the new field will be accessible in ePathway, via Pathway UX (System Menu >> System Administration >> ePathway >> System Processing >> Web Server Export) - Response Field Export.

The Detail Response Type Layout shown in Image 2 now allows selection of the Personal Details fields which will display on the Response Detail Enquiry screen. This field displays the Personal Details submitted by a non-registered ePathway user which was previously appended to the Summary Details field and will automatically be redacted if the Response was submitted with Hide Personal Details ticked on by the respondent. It should be noted that the data in the Summary Details field is no longer redacted, under those circumstances, as the sensitive details are now removed.

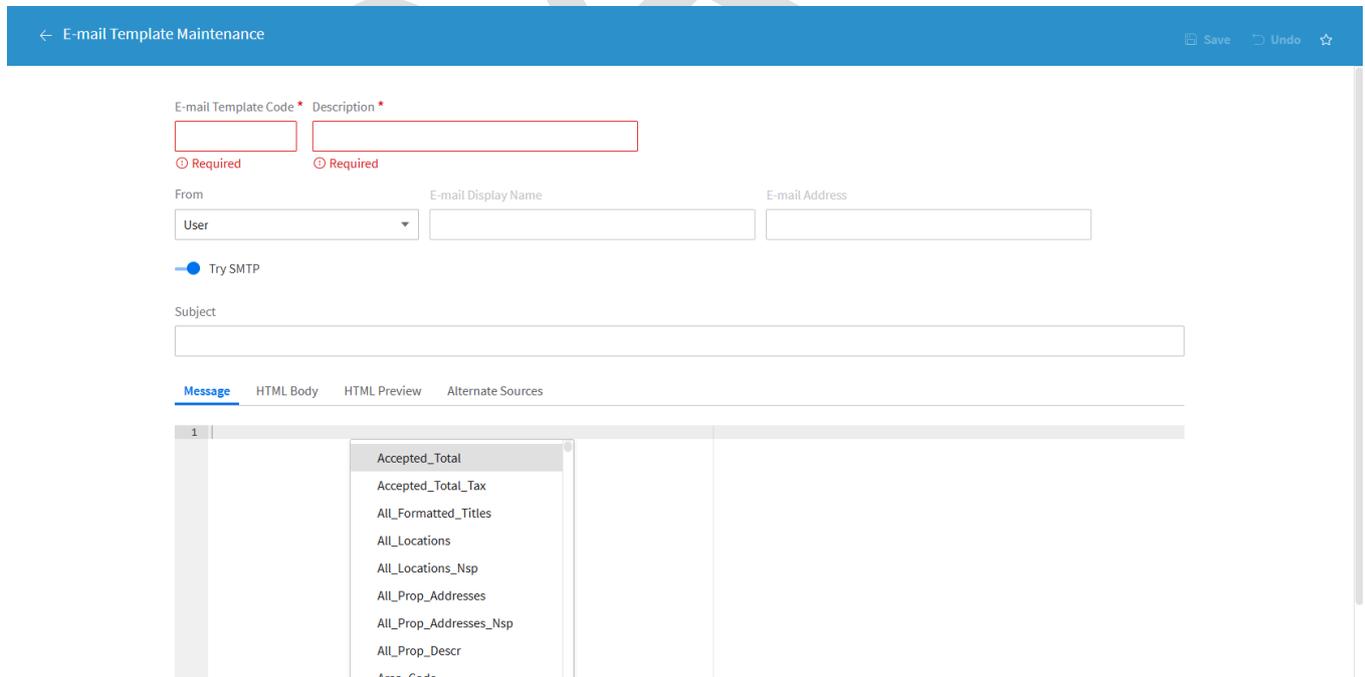

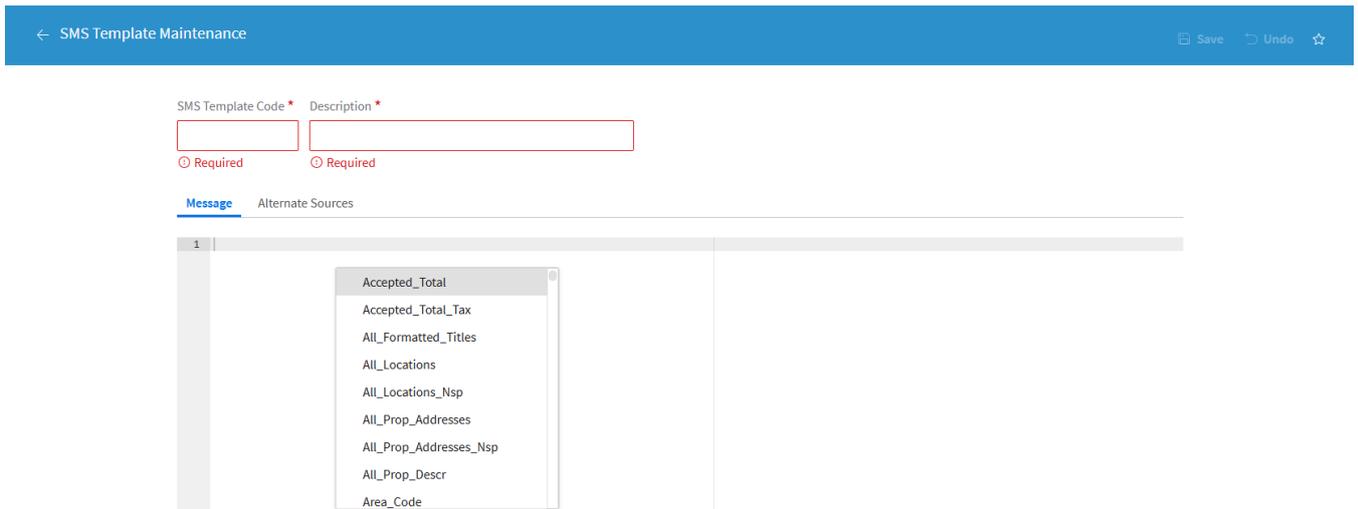

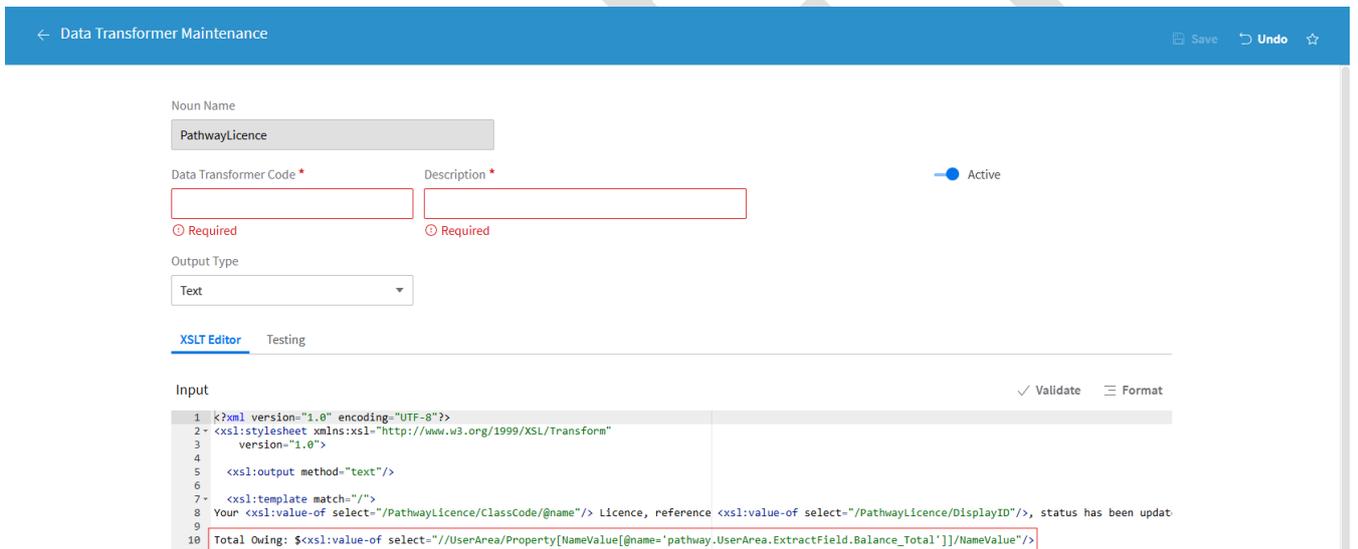
