### Chapter 1. Overview

.

The Conversion Server is a framework to manage file conversion processes used to transform native files into other viewable formats, such as TIFF or PDF.

The following document walks through installation of the HTML to PDF Converter, used to convert HTML into PDF files.

### Chapter 2. Prerequisites

Before proceeding, you need to install a Conversion Server and ensure that you meet the additional prerequisites.

For instructions on installing a conversion server, see the Infor PLM Accelerate - Installation Guide.

### Feature License Key

The HTML to PDF Converter requires a Feature License in order to run.

To check whether a valid Feature License exists in Infor PLM Accelerate:

- 1. Log into Infor PLM Accelerate as an administrator.
- 2. Go to Administration --> Feature Licenses.
- 3. If an Aras.HTMLtoPDFConverter feature license is found, check the expiration date to confirm that the license is still active.

#### **Requesting a Feature License**

Enter Infor's support portal at <u>www.infor.com/inforxtreme</u> to request a license key and to download any related installation documentation.

#### Installing the License

Once you have the activation key, install the feature license as follows:

- 1. Log into Infor PLM Accelerate as an administrator.
- 2. From the main menu toolbar, select Tools --> Admin --> Licenses --> Activate Feature.

3. Paste the acquired activation key and click **Activate Feature**.

A success message should pop up similar to the one shown below.



## Chapter 3. Installing the HTML to PDF Converter

The HTML to PDF Converter consists of files that get imported on top of the existing Conversion Server.

#### **Installation Process**

To install the HTML to PDF Converter:

1. Copy the Aras HTML to PDF Converter package to a local drive on the Conversion Server.

2. Copy the 'ConversionServer' folder to the root directory where the Conversion Server was installed, overwriting the existing 'ConversionServer' folder and its contents.

3. Restart IIS.

#### Configuring the Conversion Server

After HTML to PDF Converter is installed, ConversionServerConfig.xml file should be configured as follows:

1. Open ConversionServerConfig.xml file for editing.

Typically, this file is located at the root of Infor PLM Accelerate code tree (Sample: C:\Program Files (x86)\Aras\Innovator\ConversionServerConfig.xml)

3. Into the section <Converters/> add:

4. Into the section <ConverterSettings/> after the comment <!-- Place here configuration sections for converters --> add:

- 5. Save and close the ConversionServerConfig.xml file.
- 6. Confirm that the Conversion Server is configured to run via the Agent Service. For details, see Section 4.1 of the *Infor PLM Accelerate Conversion Server Setup Guide*.
