Chapter 1 Overview

Localizations Introduction

In meeting local legal and fiscal requirements, System21 contains function within Core product as well as providing localization menu(s) for specific reporting requirements

Infor Localization Services also provides solutions to meet country specific legal and fiscal requirements for reporting, banking and tax; some of these solutions have been adopted by System21

Adoption depends on the component being adopted:

- For GEMS, this is usually done by each deliverable (for example, it could be done for all GEMS messages for a country, or specifically for a payment type e.g. SEPA in a country, or across multiple countries)
- For LSP, this is done by function
- For products, like the Brazil Suite, this is done by module

Core Product

Functionality exists in the core applications which meet some Italian accounting requirements. When a General Ledger company is defined as Italian (country code IT) the following country specific parameters automatically set are relevant:

- Tax registers active
- Registration date applicable

- Sundry tax postings inactive
- Withholding tax active
- · Adjustment journals allowed
- Italian statutory reports
- · Check that date & period correspond
- Year-end journal active
- Accounting calendar active
- Third party bills active
- Value date active
- Partita active

There are also some core 'Z' menus that contain Italian function (APZ, ARZ, CSZ and GLZ). The details of these are described in detail in the relevant product guides

Customs Invoices

This allows the entry of transactions to the tax subsystem for reporting purposes, without creation of Accounts Payable or General Ledger postings.

See the Accounts Payable Product Guide for more details.

Italian Reporting

System21 offers various legal reports for Italy which are detailed later within this guide. To activate set-up needed for these reports the country specific functions must be active for:

00008 Italian Statutory reports

00011 Year-end journal active

Within the General Ledger company profile the General journal books should be set to indicate how the Giornale Generale is run:

If it is continuous then this should be set to 1 i.e. a Giornale report started at beginning of year will show all transactions including prior year adjustments and y/e journal (these are shown highlighted with an asterisk) with system date they were entered

If there is a separate book for each year then this should be set to 2; in this case any prior year adjustments are shown at end of previous years reports and have a date in that year

Journal adjustments

In Italy, non-auditable changes can be made to postings, up to the point where these postings are reported to the government via the Giornale Generale, at which point a sequential number is assigned to the General Ledger transactions and adjustment is prohibited.

As such, an Accounts Payable Item Amend and General Ledger Journal Amend are available for Italy.

Country specific parameter '00007 Adjustment journals allowed?' should be set to '1'.

Partially Recoverable VAT

System21 allows a tax code to be specified as Partial Rate; this means that a proportion of the tax is non-reclaimable on purchases. The system automatically expenses off the non-reclaimable portion either to the account defined to the tax code or to the cost account if no separate account has been defined.

See the General Ledger Product Guide for more details.

Partita

Partita (or batch) allows the cross referencing of transactions based on allocation e.g. invoices and payments; System21 allows creation and maintenance of partitas in Italy.

Country specific parameter '00030 Partita active?' should be set to '2'.

Postings are assigned a unique system-generated partita number composed of the year and item reference; when partita items are allocated, the relevant partitas are consolidated into the lowest partita reference.

See the Accounts Receivable and Accounts Payable product guides for more details.

Tax on Miscellaneous Transactions

System21 allows posting of tax against miscellaneous transactions, for instance on General Ledger journals.

This functionality should be switched off for Italy so all tax postings only go through Accounts Receivable and Accounts Payable against a customer or supplier, in order that the correct tax details can be recorded/reported. Entry of tax details must be inhibited in other standard options.

Country specific parameter '00004 Sundry tax postings inactive?' should be set to '1' to prevent tax postings on miscellaneous transactions for Italy.

Tax Registers

A tax register is a subdivision of tax transactions within a company. All taxable documents, whether Accounts Receivable or Accounts Payable, are associated with a register, and a sequential (protocol) number generated.

For Accounts Receivable, the protocol number in an Italian system is typically the same as the invoice number. In System21, field limitation sizes on invoice number mean that the two are separate and System21 generates the protocol number from the register.

The system maintains integrity of the numbering, ensuring that protocols are unique (within year) and allowing gaps in sequence to be filled.

Country specific parameter '00001 Tax registers active?' should be set to '1' to allow the use of tax registers for Italy.

See the General Ledger Product Guide for more details on how to maintain tax registers and protocol gaps.

Six type of register are provided:

- 1 Sales
- 2 Purchases
- 3 Suspended sales
- 4 Suspended purchases
- 5 Scorporo
- 6 Ventilation

Sales transactions are posted to a sales register of type 1

Purchases to a purchase register of type 2.

If tax payments are suspended until an invoice is paid, suspended sales and suspended purchases registers are used (register type 3 and 4 respectively); once payments are received and tax is liable, a transaction is then written to registers of types 1 or 2.

For the suspended sales and suspended purchases registers, these are defined as the target registers.

For acquisition tax (when both input and output tax are charged), then a target sales register should be defined against the purchase register so that when an invoice is posted, the input is included in the purchase register and output in the sales register

Type 5 Scorporo register is used for petty cash sales only.

Type 6 registers are not used.

When tax registers are active, customers and suppliers have a default tax register defined and when transactions are processed register details should be entered. See the Accounts Payable Product Guide and the Accounts Receivable Product Guide for details.

Third Party Collections

In Italy a customer may settle a debt by passing it on to a third party. The debt is cleared from the customer account but must instead be collected from the third party. System21 allows collection documents to be assigned details for a third party

To activate this function, country specific parameter '00028 Third party bills active?' should be set to active.

Third parties can be defined in Cash Management and then selected when collection documents are created for customers

See the Cash Management Product Guide for further details

Transaction Dates and Periods

In Italy, there is a requirement to ensure dates and posting periods are consistent.

Within System21 in order to ensure this control is in place, country specific functions must be active

00002 Registration date applicable

00010 Check that date & period correspond

00014 Accounting calendar active

The accounting date function allows General Ledger calendar periods to be flagged as either open or closed; the period open/close sets these flags automatically but they may also be maintained manually within the calendar.

During posting, the posting period is set from the tax (registration) date; this date & posting period must be consistent.

Value Dates

Value date function allows the definition of the number of days that it takes for payments to fully clear the banking system.

A table by payment method and bank account is maintained, showing the number of days to clear for each of receivables, payables and cash management transactions. These can be further analysed into local, national and inter-national transactions. A value date field is then maintained by the system against transactions, by applying the appropriate number of days to the document date.

The value date can also be directly maintained against a transaction by the user.

Country specific parameter '00029 Value date active?' should be set to '1' if you want the date to be calculated but not be capable of override. Set it to '2' if you want it to be calculated and also be capable of override.

Withholding Tax

Withholding tax is a form of advance income tax applicable to self-employed/professional persons, who are set up as suppliers in Accounts Payable. Within System21 analysis codes and withholding rates can be defined against a supplier. When an invoice is posted, these can be overridden. The amount of withholding tax defined against a supplier is deducted from the supplier payment and transferred to a 'government' supplier for payment.

Country specific parameter '00006 Withholding tax' should be set to '1' to meet Italian withholding tax requirements of tax withheld at payment.

A specific government supplier should be maintained and included in General Ledger parameter GOVS Tax Supplier. Sub-codes should also be maintained in the parameters NTCD National Code and WTAX Withholding Tax. When a supplier is set-up, withholding tax should be set to active, if applicable and additional details entered like the government supplier, the tax rate etc.

During invoice posting, withholding tax will be calculated on invoice values, but may be overridden; on invoice payment, the amount paid is reduced by the withheld amount which is then posted to the government supplier automatically.

See the General Ledger and Accounts Payable product guides for further details.

Year-end processing

Function is provided to formally close and open the financial accounts at the end of an accounting year. System 21 provides the ability to post a year end journal to close a financial year, and a year open journal to bring forward account balances.

Similarly, customer & supplier balances are netted off in the last period of the year and a net debit or net credit rolled forward into the first period of the new year.

In order to activate this function, the Use Year-end Journals flag should be checked in the GL Company profile, and the Number of Adjustment Periods set. Additional general ledger accounts are also defined in the company profile for the open/close and the profit/loss postings.

At year end, the Year Close Journal (11/GLC) should be used to process the year-end and year-open journals. This will generate year-end journals to zeroize the profit and loss accounts and clear down all the balance sheet accounts using the last adjustment period of the year, create an appropriation journal to post the net profit/loss for the year to retained earnings, and generate a year-open journal to post the opening balances for the new year.

The number of adjustment periods will need to be set to at least 1 (to be used for the year-close journal) but may be greater to allow adjustments to be posted after the year end.

Note: Once the year end journal is posted, no further adjustments to the year may be made

Italian Banking

System 21 provides the ability to enter bank details in the correct format for Italy; either as a BBAN:


Bank Detail

Accounting Reports

Stampa Giornale Generale [1/IX]

Use this task to generate the Giornale Generale

The Giornale General report (or 'Journal book') details all GL movements to all GL accounts up to a selected end date. Movements are reported in date sequence, with each transaction line numbered uniquely, with separate debit and credit value columns. The report shows only fiscal accounts (extensions are not shown).

The report can be run many times provisionally; however, once the final report is processed, the GL journal lines are updated with the line number reported. to ensure that they are excluded from future reports

The following cumulative balances are shown:

- Opening debit and credit balances (the closing balances from the previous report)
- Daily totals for debits and credits
- Closing balances for debit and credits (for the definitive report, these are stored on the system to be printed as opening balances for the next report)

The report caters for an overlay situation (sovapposizione) which allows for the fiscal periods in a new fiscal year to be opened and closed as normal, but allows the prior year adjustment period to remain open for up to six months. Transactions and balances relating to the prior year are printed with a `*' next to them, when the company is running a single Giornale General book.

Historically Italian companies maintained two sets of books – one for the previous year, one for the current. Thus all the adjustments would appear on the final book for last year, leaving the current year unaffected. Now, it is usual to run a single Giornale General which holds two sets of opening/daily/closing totals – one for current year, one for prior year – during the overlay situation.

Note: Use the Gestione sovapposizione option (3/IX) to activates the year end overlay situation and allow for the new year period processing whilst the adjustment periods remain open. This is usually run before the Giornale Generale report is run in the first period of the new year. It will activates the control of two sets of balances on the Giornale Generale report when running one set of books.

Giornale Generale Selection Window

To display this window, select the Stampa Giornale Generale task.

Use this window to select the GL transaction(s) to be reported

Fields

Data limite movimenti (Cut off date for the report)

Enter the date up to which transactions should be included

This should be greater than the last definitive report run date, and not be greater than the last date in the current fiscal year

The system will also check that transactions exist from the last run date to the entered cut-off date, if none exist, a message is displayed.

Stampa Provv/definitive (Print provisional / definitive)

Select whether the report is provisional (0) or definitive (1)

Where the definitive report is run, the transactions are updated with the line number they appeared in of the report so they cannot be selected again

Codici estensione conti (Account extension codes)

Select the consolidation level for the report:

Set to Dettaglio (D) to show separate lines for each posting

Set to Raggruppati (R) to consolidate lines within transactions with the same account code

Esercizio Precedente (Print report for previous year)

Only applicable when two Giornale Generale books are in use

Use this to print the report for last year.

Movimenti da includere (Types of transactions to include)

Select one of the following types of transactions to include:

TUTTI i movimenti/All (1)

solo ACQUISTI/Only purchases (2)

solo VENDITE/Only sales (3)

solo CASSA/BANCA/Only cash movements (4)

Note: Memo postings are always excluded.

Press ENTER to validate the data and Conferma (F8) to submit the report

Note: The transaction descriptions included are based on the GL parameter GIOR which needs to be set-up by the users.

These appear in the 'Tipo operazione' column.

Note: Italy can run 1 or 2 books. This is defined on GL company profile

If set to 1, then it is a continuous book: A Giornale report started at beginning of year will show all transactions including prior year adjustments and year end journal (these are shown highlighted with an asterisk) with the system date they were entered

If set to 2, then there is a separate book for each year: As such prior year adjustments are shown at end of previous years reports and have a date in that year

Note: In order to re-print the Giornale Generale, the FLP021 report control file needs to be re-set to the date that the previous definitive report was run (JLDT21) and the last line number of the previous

report (JLSQ21) along with the last cumulative debit and credit values (JLCD21 / JLCC21). Note that during the overlay situation 2 records will exist - one for last year, one for this year. Both sets will need to be down-dated. This can be achieved either by using Option 2/IX, or through using system facilities to change the FLP021 file directly. In addition the FLP008 records which have JLSQ08 greater than the last line number printed on the previous Giornale Generale report will need to be reset to zero. This will need to be done using system facilities i.e. SQL.

Manutenzione Date e Progressive [2/IX]

This task allows the user to correct the control file used by the Giornale Generale, in respect of dates, sequential numbering and values, in order to adjust for a reporting error, or to manually reset the data to allow the report to be reprinted.

Where a single Giornale Generale book is in use the Esercizio precedente will be input inhibited.

Maintain Giornale Generale Selection Window

To display this window, select the Manutenzione date e progressive task.

Use this window to amend the report numbers and values as required

<u>Fields</u>

Data ultima stampa

This the date of the latest report; amend as required

Numero ultima riga

This the last line number of the latest report; amend as required

Progressivo DARE/AVERE

These are the cumulative debit and credit values reported; amend as required

Press Conferma (F8) to confirm any amendments

Gestione Sovrapposizione [3/IX]

Use this task to activate the year end overlay situation where the new year period processing continues whilst the adjustment period remains open. The function is usually run before the Giornale Generale report is run in the first period of the new year. It will activate the control of two sets of balances on the Giornale Generale report when running one set of books.

Overlay Management Window

To display this window, select the Gestione sovrapposizione task.

Use this window to activate the overlay situation

Fields

Condiz. Attuale sovrapposizione

Use this to activate the overlay situation

Spost. Progressivi ad anno preced.

This allows the two sets of balances to be maintained, by taking the figures held for the last definitive report and moving them to last year's record.

Press Conferma (F8) to confirm any amendments

Stampa Mastrini [4/IX]

Use this task to create a report to show the opening balance, movements and closing balance, for any account or range of accounts, for a particular date range.

This report can be used as a supporting document for the Giornale Generale.

Mastrini Report Selection Window

To display this window, select the Stampa Mastrini task.

Use this window to enter the selection criteria for the report

Fields

Codice mastro

Enter the ledger to be reported; leave blank to select all ledgers

A prompt is available

Codice conto iniziale / finale

Enter a range of GL accounts; leave blank to select all accounts

A prompt is available

Data Limite iniziale / finale

Enter the date range for the transactions to be reported

Select the consolidation level for the report:

Set to Dettaglio (D) to show separate lines for each posting

Set to Raggruppati (R) to consolidate lines within transactions with the same account code

Saldi iniziale

Select to include opening balances

Totali Giornalieri

Select to show daily summary balances

Solo conti movimenti

Select to only include accounts with movement

Stampa registraz. Completa

Use this to select to print all of the related lines of the journals, although all lines will not be included in the totals for the account.

Descrizione registrazione

Select to print the journal description

Descrizione Riga

Select to print the journal line description

Tipo conto da includere

Select which types of account to include (Memo, Fiscal or Both)

Press Conferma (F8) to validate the entries and submit the report

VAT (IVA) Reporting

Stampa Registri IVA [10/IX]

Use this task to produce a detailed VAT report listing transactions for a chosen tax register in date and protocol number order; it will include a summary of the values of the transactions by VAT code at the end of the report, which should reconcile to the summary report produced monthly (11/IX)

An error report will be produced detailing any gaps, sequence errors or duplicates

Note: The transaction descriptions included are based on the GL parameter VATR which needs to be set-up by the users.

These appear in the 'Operazione/Assogettamento' column.

The 'I**' codes are specifically added to allow a different description for the acquisitions postings.

Registri IVA Report Selection Window

To display this window, select the Stampa Registri task.

Use this window to enter the selection criteria for the report

Fields

Codice registro

Enter the VAT register to be reported

A prompt is available

Data limite movimenti

Enter the cut-off date for the transactions to be reported

Stampa provv/definitive

Select whether the report is provisional (0) or definitive (1)

Where the definitive report is run, the transactions are updated as printed on the report so they cannot be selected again

Controllo protocolli

This is only applicable when running a provisional mode

Select to check protocol numbers and generate reports showing gaps, sequence errors and duplicate protocols.

Press Conferma (F8) to validate the entries and submit the report

Stampa Liquidazione IVA [11/IX]

Use this task to produce a summary of the information presented in the detail VAT register (Stampa Registri).

This report is used to derive the actual figure to be paid to, or in theory received from, the Italian fiscal authorities.

Liquidazione Report Selection Window

To display this window, select the Stampa Liquidazione task.

Use this window to enter the selection criteria for the report

Fields

Data limite movimenti

Enter the cut-off date for the report; this should be consistent with the detail report

Stampa provv/definitive

Select whether the report is provisional (0) or definitive (1)

For a definitive report, the definitive detail report should have already been run

Where the definitive report is run, the VAT outstanding balance on the Statutory Reports file is updated

Press Conferma (F8) to validate the entries and submit the report

Controllo Annuale Registri [12/IX]

Use this task to produce same information as presented in the monthly report (Stampa Liquidazione) for a year

Annuale Registri Report Selection Window

To display this window, select the Controllo Annuale Registri task.

Use this window to enter the selection criteria for the report

Fields

Movimenti relativi all'anno

Enter the year to be reported

This defaults to the current fiscal year; valid years are restricted to current year +/1 1

Press Conferma (F8) to validate the entry and submit the report

Manutenzione IVA a Credito [13/IX]

Use this task to maintain the cumulative VAT liability calculated and stored by the last VAT report run (11/IX)

Maintain VAT Liability Window

To display this window, select the Manutenzione IVA a credito task.

Use this window to maintain the reported VAT liability

Fields

Enter the year to be modified

This defaults to the current fiscal year; valid years are restricted to current year +/1 1

Nuovo credits IVA

Enter the corrected balance to be written to the Statutory Reports file

Press Conferma (F8) to update the balance

Manutenzione IVA Compensate [14/IX]

Use this task to maintain the cumulative VAT paid and stored by the last VAT report run (11/IX)

Maintain VAT Paid Window

To display this window, select the Manutenzione IVA compensate task.

Use this window to maintain the VAT paid

Use this task to generate pre-numbered stationery with the company name printed which may be used for Giornale Generale (1/IX) and Liquidazione (11/IX)

To display this window, select the Numerazione libri bollati task.

Use this window to enter the details to be used on the stationery

Enter the year to be used

Enter the page numbers to/from required

Press Conferma (F8) to generate the stationery

Elenco Clienti e Fornitori [16/IX]

Use this task to create a file of tax details, which contains summary totals of various categories of the billing and tax by customer and supplier VAT IDs.

It uses the standard GL extract (also available via 11/GLV) to create work-files of the movements for a year by customer and supplier, and then automatically also runs an Italian specific formatting program to create a file of data.

Note: The customer and supplier details are summarised by VAT ID in the formatting program, so if two customers share a single VAT ID they will only be reported once.

Note: It is not necessary to use option 11/GLV: everything is run from this one option.

Required Setup

Country specific parameter '00058 VAT Extract period' should be set to '4'. This ensures that the data is extracted by document date.

The company's own name and address and tax details should be defined in the GL company profile. These are accessed via function key F15.

Note: The external company name, town and province fields, tax registration number (VAT ID) and company registration code (fiscal code) are the fields used in the reporting.

VAT IDs for customers and suppliers should be maintained; the Italian VAT id validation is run where the country code is set to IT and the 11 digit numeric number entered in the VAT ID field; where the country prefix is to be used in the VAT ID then no validation will be performed and for reporting purposes then maintain the VTID parameter in GL parameters (32/GLA), and set the value against the IT sub-code to 13 rather than 11 (default)

In order to distinguish between the following types of VAT:

Taxable shown on invoice (1)

Taxable not shown on invoice (2)

Non-taxable (3)

Exempt (4)

Any non-zero rate VAT code will be assumed to be of type (1) and any zero rate VAT code will be assumed to be of type (3).

Where transactions use type (2) and type (4) VAT, then the VAT codes appropriate to these types will need to be defined in GL parameter maintenance (32/GLA).

Define any type (2) VAT codes as sub codes against parameter type ITTN.

Define any type (4) VAT codes as sub codes against parameter type ITEX.

This will ensure that such transactions can be correctly identified in the file

The reporting program also needs to distinguish credit notes that relate to invoices originally raised in a prior tax year. The identification of prior year credits needs to be done by entering an appropriate credit reason code against the credit note, when it is created in OE (or a similar billing application), AR or AP.

These reason codes also then need to be defined in GL parameter maintenance (32/GLA).

Define any OE or AR reason codes as sub codes against parameter type ITAR.

Define any AP reason codes as sub codes against parameter type ITAP.

The values consist of various types of data:
